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Connecting with Pioneering Organisations and Battery Experts

BatPower strengthens cooperation between VET, industry, R&D and higher education.

A central ambition of BatPower is to build a stakeholder network that can support long-term cooperation in battery energy education. During the project, partners identified organisations with advanced knowledge of battery technologies and collected insights that could support training content and future collaboration.

Stakeholder mapping

Under WP2, the consortium identified pioneering companies, institutes, universities and organisations working with BatTech know-how. The project reached and exceeded the target of 50 relevant organisations. This stakeholder mapping helped partners understand who can contribute expertise, examples, consultation and potential dissemination opportunities.

Industry insight

InoBat, the associated partner from Slovakia, supported the project in the early phase by providing insights into battery R&D and production. The consortium also used expert consultations and later study visits, such as Maroti Academy, ENAIP Varese, a Volkswagen-Skoda dealership, University of Valencia, Power Electronics and ITE, to connect project development with real practice.

Why this network matters

Stakeholder cooperation supports several project goals at once. It improves the technical relevance of the materials, supports validation, creates routes for dissemination and helps VET institutions understand labour market needs. For stakeholders, it offers the possibility to follow the development of new BatTech training resources and contribute to future cooperation.

- Promote BatTech education through networks and events.
- Create cooperation opportunities beyond the project lifetime.
